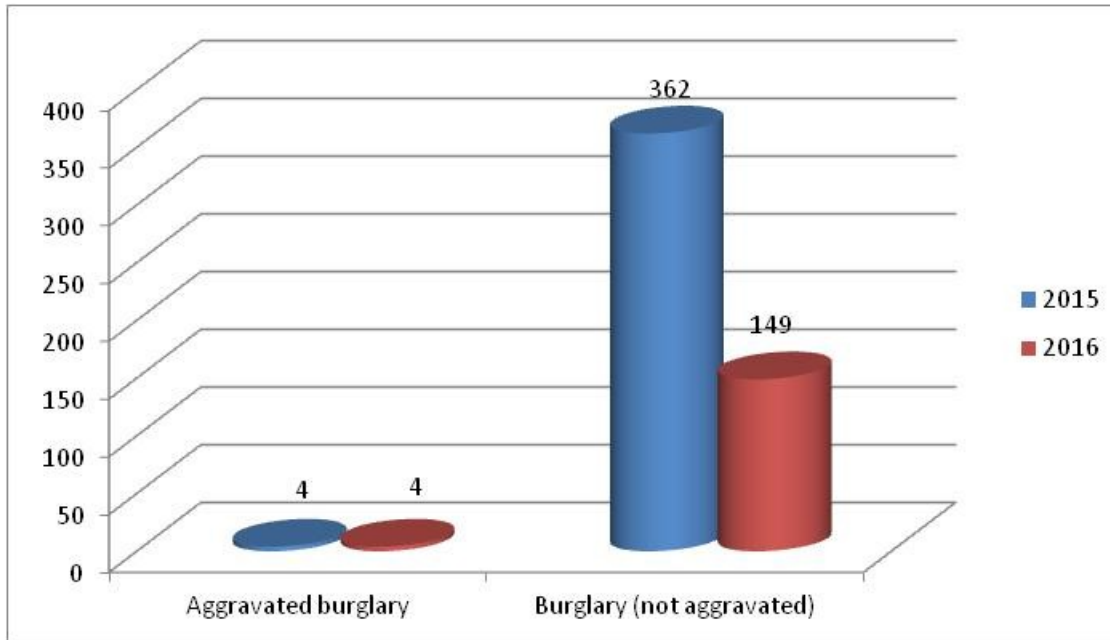

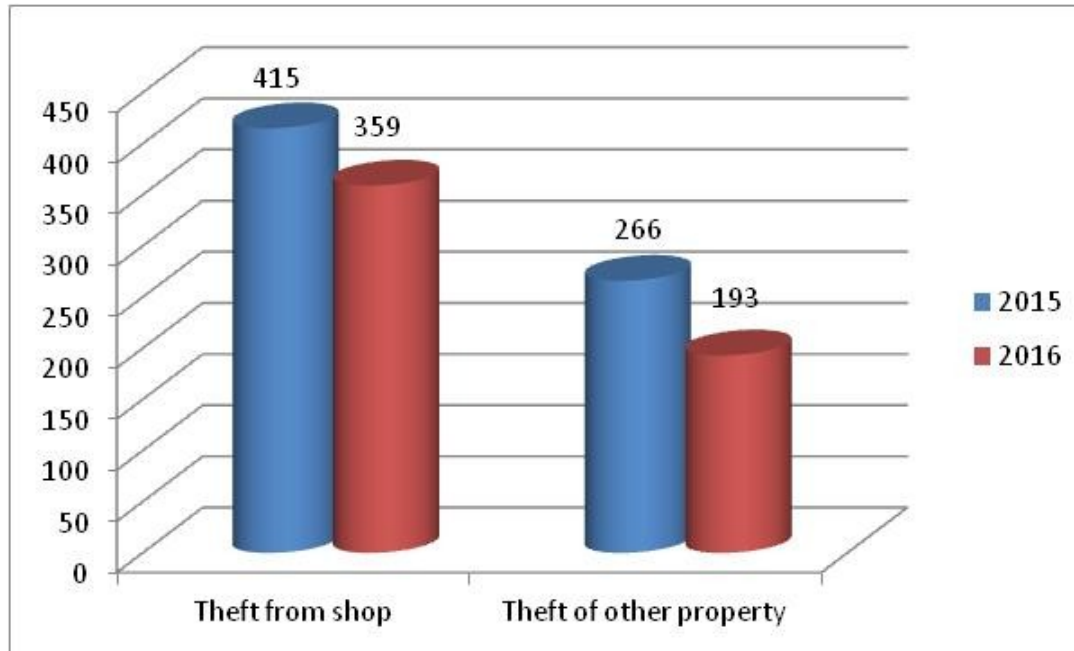
Theft of vehicle / Theft from Vehicle 2015 v 2016



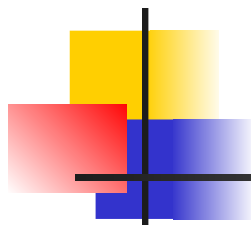

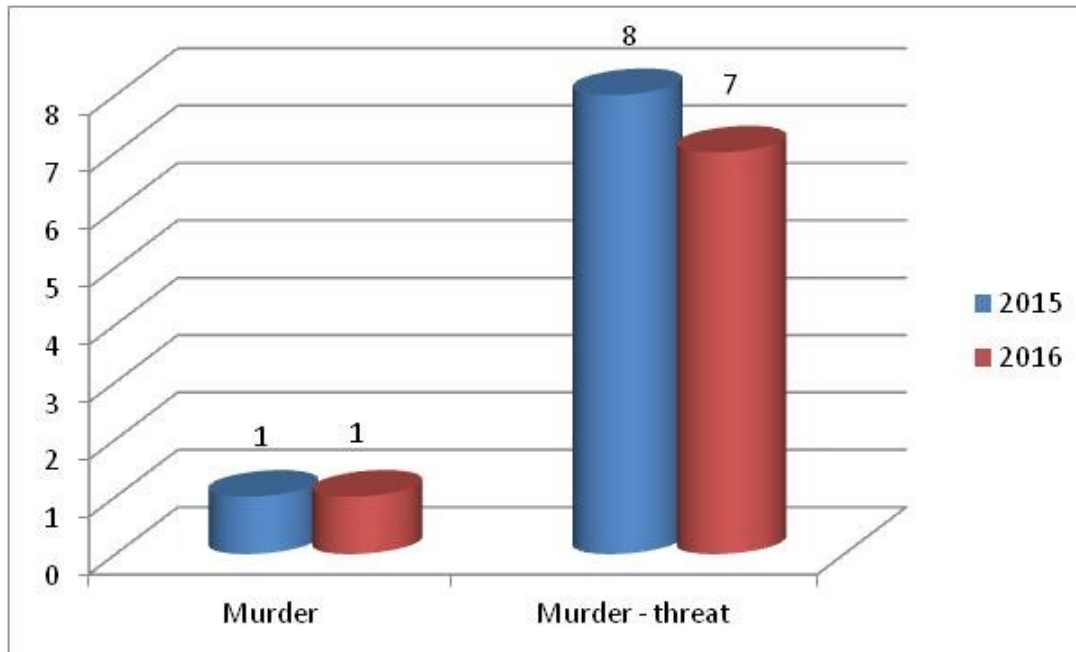

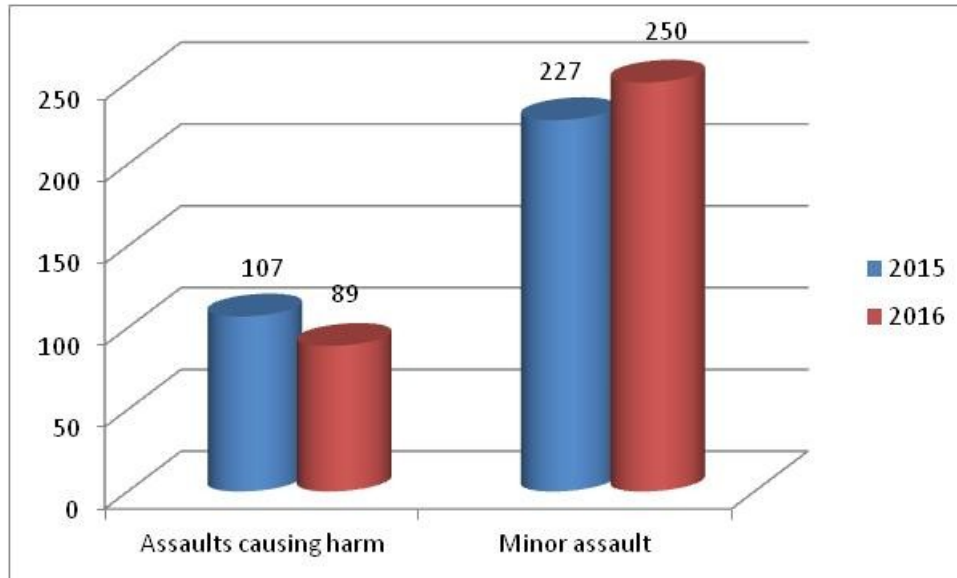

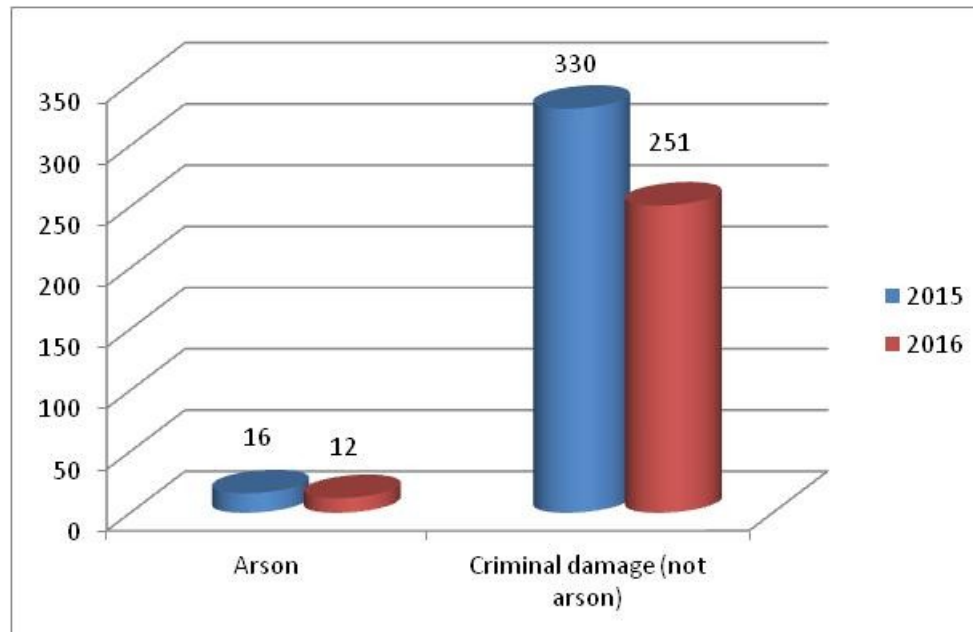

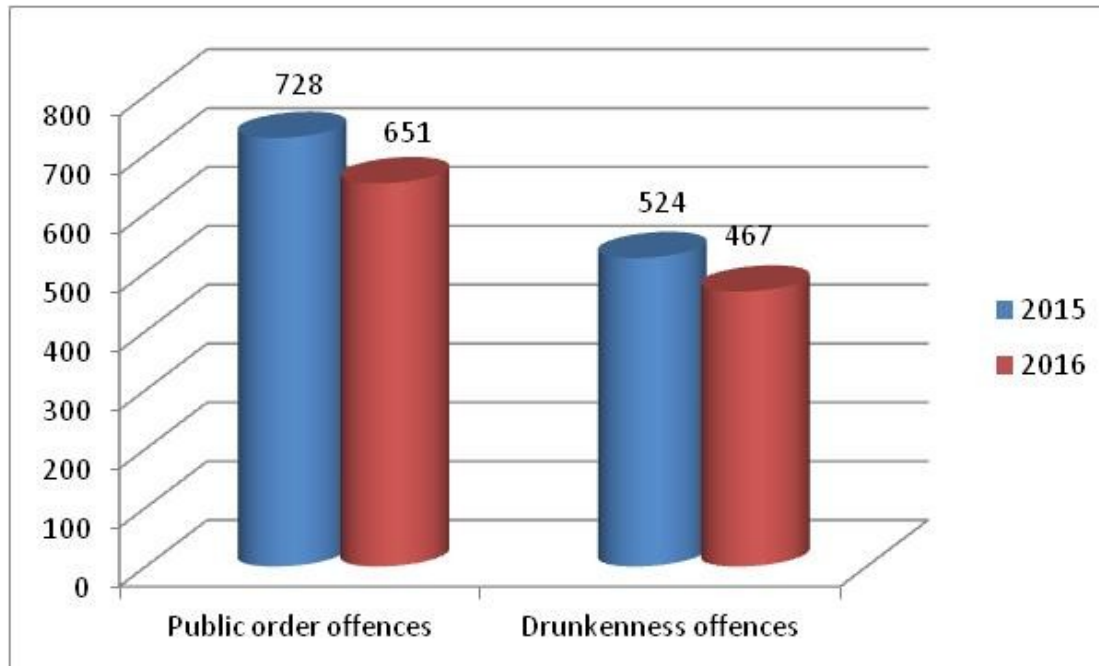

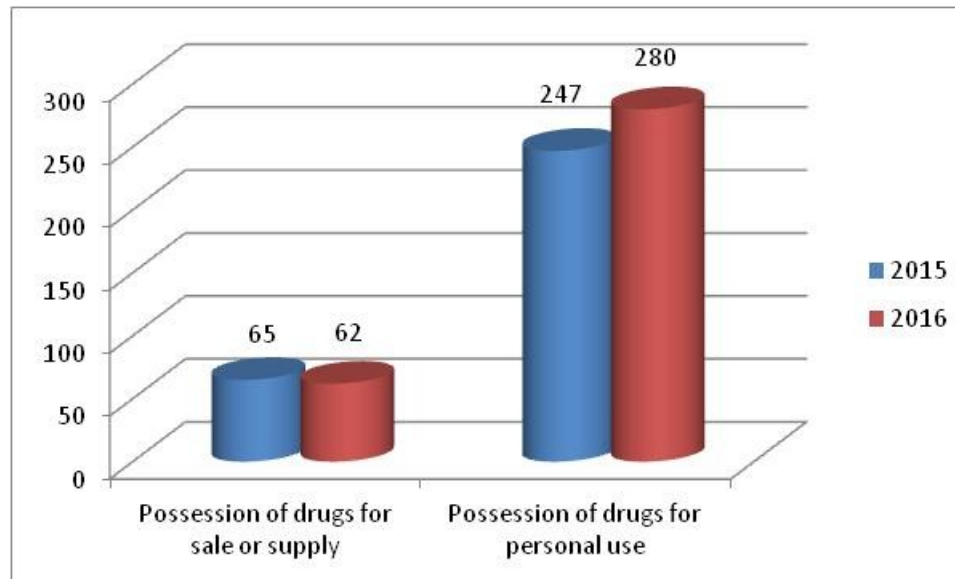

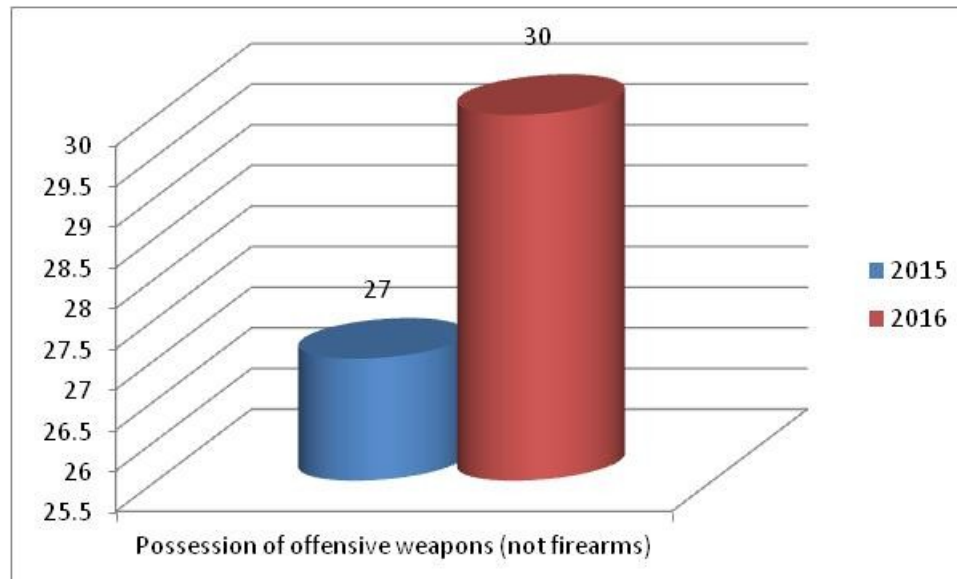
Drugs & Offensive Weapons

Drugs 2015 v 2014

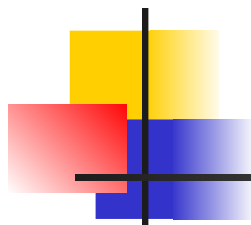

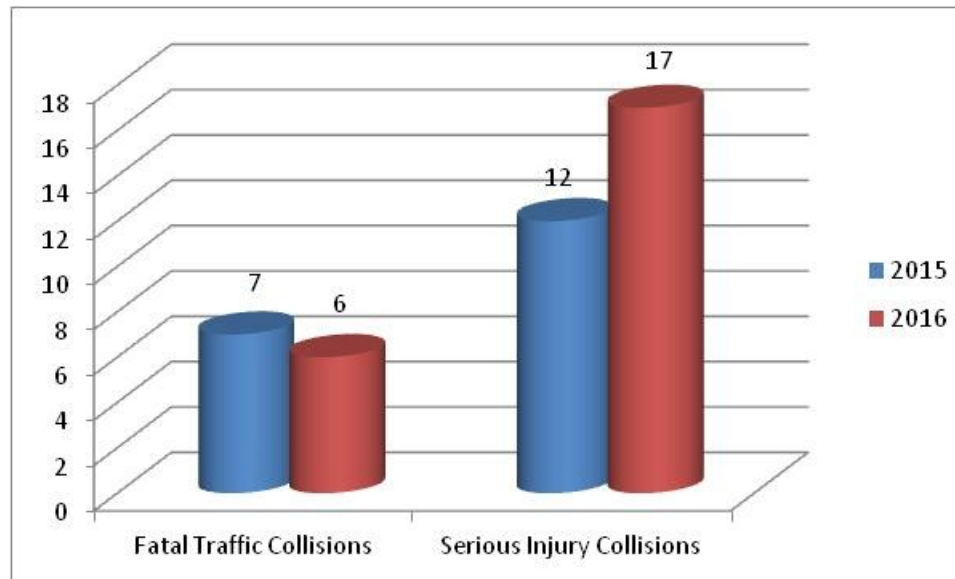

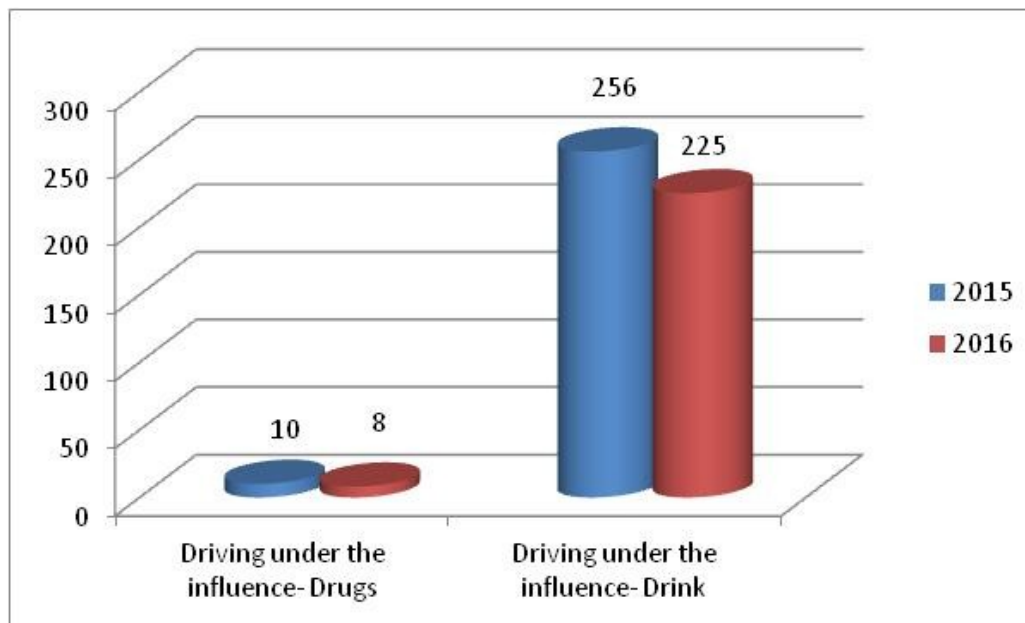
Traffic Collisions

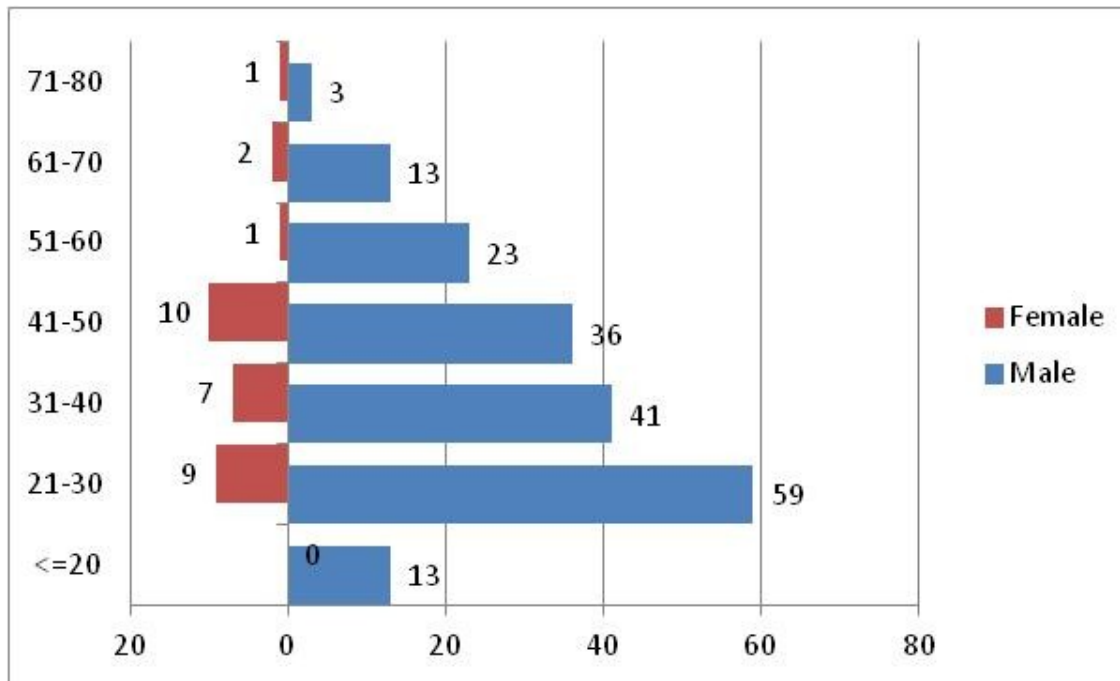
Intoxicated while Driving 2015 v 2016

- The Kerry Division are endeavouring to increase the number of Text Alert, Community Alert and Neighbourhood Watch Groups at present.



National Property Recovered Day

22nd September 2016 - Review

- Took place at Castleisland Garda station – 22/9/16
- The Crime Prevention Officer, Garda Victims Officer Personnel, PEMS Officer and members of the Community Policing Unit attended.
- The basic concept behind this initiative was to reunite/return property to the public and it is envisaged further action days will be arranged.
- Members of the Public were made aware of the dedicated day via social media and local media outlets. **A key learning for AGS was the need to engage to a greater degree with social media and this has now been actioned.**
